

2007 Alumni Regatta Rules

-Teams are comprised, when possible, of individuals who started rowing for Case during the same academic year.

-All races are 500m except for the finals. Time permitting; the finals are on the 1500m course used for the Cleveland Home Schools Regatta. Should the regatta be behind schedule, the coaches may decide to shorten the final to 500m.

-Two 4+s will be used and hot seated throughout the regatta. Whichever boat began rowing at Case earlier will receive choice of boats. Should both lineups be from the same year, the highest lettered lineup will have choice of boat (2006 A has priority over 2006 B, etc). All lineups have boat choice over an "inactive" or "exhibition" lineup. Alumni always get the first choice!

-Preliminary Rounds:

The lineups are split into two men's pools and two women's pools. Each team will race all other boats in its pool. A team will receive 1 point for a win, and 0 for a loss. The team in each pool with the most points at the end of preliminary play will advance to the final. In the event of a tie, the team with the fastest net time will advance.

-Exhibition Boats:

The women's pool B contains two teams and an exhibition boat. The exhibition boat will not receive any points, but 1 point will be rewarded to a team for beating an exhibition boat.
